With the support of our suppliers, we work closely with our customers to understand your specific project requirements and develop the most cost effective cable supply solution.

One example of this occured during the development of the Shellharbour Mall, in NSW. A cable run of more than 7km of 240mm 3c copper cable needed to be laid along a fairly difficult path.

Traditionally a large and difficult project such as this would have seen the customer, in this case Connect Infrastructure, purchase standard quantities of full drum packs and incur large amounts of cable waste. Instead, ARS Sydney branch worked with the supplier, Olex (for this project) to minimise the wastage by providing a cut-to-length service. Project Manager at Connect, Grant Richards commented; "The service made the drums easier to handle and we were able to stagger the delivery at a time

when we needed it".

The ARS Cut-to-Length service is based upon common usage cables and can offer the shortest lead time for customers as it is forecast by the manufacturer. ARS can store the bulk drums and deliver exact lengths of cable to a predeterrmined destination and time. This allows the customer complete control over their supply. As an on-going service, All Round Supplies can then send the project team a spread sheet update, at regular intervals, detailing the drums supplied for the project, previously supplied lengths and quantity remaining on each drum for planning the next run lengths. 11kV Underground Cable Damaged by Excavator

#### Incident Details

An Authorised Person (AUP) was in the cable pit removing the slurry with a shovel. An excavator with a toothless bucket was lowered into the trench to assist with the removal of the slurry. During the process, the excavator inadvertently scored the outer sheath of the High Voltage Cable. No injury resulted from this contact, but its a timely reminder of precautions that should be taken.

#### Actions to be Taken:

- 1 Consult with the Worksite Co-ordinator to determine any unidentified hazards prior to work.
- 2 Potholing must be used to identify the asset location, direction & depth prior to excavation.
- 3 Assume on active sites that DBYD plans may not be current; ensure that Worksite Hazard & Risk Assessment identifies this hazard.

#### **UPDATE: IPC replaces PG for 11kV HV CCT**

As per Endeavour Energy TB-0102, Sicame IPCs will now replace parallel groove (PG) clamps, for all new 11kV CCT to CCT connections for 40, 80 and 120mm<sup>2</sup> CCT in non-tension situations.

The installation of the new IPC will eliminate previous window stripping and will be considerably quicker to carry out. Refer to ARS stock code: 06517 (pictured right)



#### **UPDATE: New Kit OXSU-FIE5**

Tyco AUST-P99 (ARS 02206) and AUST-P44 (ARS 02688) have now been incorporated into the new OXSU-FIE5 (ARS 06670) 11kV/22kV XLPE outdoor termination kit. The double-hole shear bolt (mechanical) lugs give the kit a wider range of cable size applications (185mm² - 300mm² for 11kV and 185mm² - 240mm² for 22kV cable terminations). ### Knots...The real test of a fisherman (by Phil Baily)

I recently visited Sydney for a conference and afterwards I stayed a couple of nights with an old friend in Camden.

Whilst I was there my mate Steve enquired as to what sort of knots I employ when fishing in the territory. First I asked Steve to show me his repertoire of knots which basically came down to a list of two! He showed me a Double Surgeons Knot for tying his hooks onto a leader and a Granny Knot.

Now Steve is not an avid fisherman but I think he is typical of many who can get away with these sort of knots, when they are not likely to encounter overly large fish.

As I started to show Steve the knots I use, it also dawned on me the differences in fishing styles. For example, I showed Steve an Albright Knot used for attaching heavy leader to a braid line for lure fishing (predominately for Barra). I then realised Steve almost exclusively bait fishes. So here are the knots I use. I also often tie a double and a special Snood Knot onto the hook shanks, which I cannot find a photos of - but if anyone is interested you can contact me at our Darwin branch on 0408 786 580 and I'll talk you through it.
