

All Round Success Story: Rapid Creek Solar Lighting

Local Northern Territory company, Bennett Design, undertook a design project on behalf of the Darwin City Council for a recreational platform to be constructed on the banks of Rapid Creek, a popular fishing location, adjacent to the car park and crossover bridge. The aim of the project was to provide access for disabled people to enjoy their fishing experience in a safe and secure environment with a unique fold down balustrade.

The platform has been built as an environmentally friendly structure which compliments the sites natural attributes and for this reason **All Round Supplies Solar Lighting** was selected and installed by the projects Electrical Contractor – Wolpers Grahl.

All Round Supplies' Solar Lighting system incorporates a 2400W Supalux IP65 Type II LED luminaire designed to suit low to medium lighting applications. The luminaire's produce a spread of light from the 24 High Quality Nichia LED chips at a temperature of 5200K and an output rate of 1789lms. The system is powered by a 12vDC 24vDC solar array and controller, all mounted on a 2.0 metre outreaches and 6 metre tapered galvanised pole which includes a battery compartment in the base of the pole. The poles needed to be anchored to the main super structure of the platform and meet applicable cyclone and wind ratings for Darwin.

ARS Nowra Branch have updated and improved their Delivery Service to best ensure on-time delivery for their customers. Some, not all, of the improved delivery guidelines are listed below:

- For FIS delivery, a minimum order value of \$500 + GST will need to be made; otherwise a \$50 delivery charge will apply.
- Pick up times from the Nowra Branch will be from 7.30am 4.00pm, unless other arrangements have been made with branch staff.
- Orders must be received by 11am the morning before the scheduled delivery day for your area. For the delivery schedule contact the Nowra Branch.
- The following items are subject to size limitations due to the nature of carriage:
 - Normal Conduit- Maximum length of 4m or less
 - Cable Drums- Maximum 1m diameter

Struck By Injury during Duct Proving

Work being performed: Pulling a cable mandrel to prove underground ducts. This process involves using a winch to pull the mandrel through the ducts. A trailing rope is attached to the mandrel to facilitate pulling back of the Aquatec (winch) rope. The trailing rope is manually unwound / wound off a freewheeling rope reel by an operator at the nontension (feed in) end.

Incident details:

During the process the mandrel became stuck in the duct. The rope pulling the mandrel stretched to a point where it eventually became free and caused the mandrel, trailing rope and trailing rope reel to be propelled forward at speed. The trailing rope reel struck the reel operator who had moved to a position in front of the reel. The worker received injuries to his ribs

Causal Factors:

• An exclusion zone around the pulling equipment was not erected or included in the SWMS.

• The mandrel became stuck in the duct causing the rope to stretch and propel the mandrel upon release.

• The trailing rope reel was not in line with ducts or secured from movement.

Actions to be taken:

• Any rope reels used in the practice of proving ducts must be secured to prevent any movement of the reel.

• Exclusion zones must be defined around the immediate work area where there is potential for harm to workers or the public.

- Update SWMS 5.010 to include the requirements of exclusion zones around pulling equipment.
- Ensure effective communication between all parties involved during the cable pull at all time.

• Review of specifications on the rope and mandrel stipulated to perform this work.
